I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund, FLAIR #64-2-516, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was created effective July 1, 1997, by Chapter 97-113, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 20.435, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides revenue sources for the fund, and defines the uses of the fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund is used for the purpose of providing health care services to department clients.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are receipts from third-party payors of health care services such as Medicare and Medicaid. According to Comptroller data, receipts to the fund for FY 1998-99 were \$4,866,081.83.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
