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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Preventive Health Services Block Grant Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Preventive Health Services Block Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR \#64-2-539, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was last recreated effective November 4, 1996, by 96-122, Laws of Florida.
II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:
A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

No reference in statutes.
2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

This fund tracks receipts and expenditures of federal block grant moneys used to support preventive health activities and services.
3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major source of revenue for the fund is the federal block grant. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$5,334,608.23.
B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
III. FISCAL ANALYSIS \& ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
