I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Preventive Health Services Block Grant Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Preventive Health Services Block Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR #64-2-539, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was last recreated effective November 4, 1996, by 96-122, Laws of Florida.
