A joint resolution proposing the creation of
Section 26 of Article I of the State
Constitution relating to prohibiting
discrimination in public employment, public
education, and public procurement of goods and

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the creation of Section 26 of Article I of the State Constitution set forth below is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this State for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

## ARTICLE I

## DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

SECTION 26. Prohibition on discrimination by state and other public or governmental entities in public employment, public education, or public procurement of goods and services.--

(a) The state, or any municipality, county, district, public college or university, or other political subdivision or governmental instrumentality of or within the state, shall not discriminate in public employment, public education, or public procurement of goods and services against any person on the basis of sex, race, ethnicity, color, or national origin. It shall not constitute discrimination for the state, or any municipality, county, district, public college or university, or other political subdivision or governmental instrumentality

1 of or within the state, to take affirmative action to promote 2 equal opportunity to the extent permissible under the United 3 States Constitution. 4 This section does not invalidate any court order 5 or consent decree that is in force as of the effective date of 6 this section, nor does it prohibit action taken to establish 7 or maintain eligibility for any federal program.
