I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Federal Rehabilitation Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Federal Rehabilitation Trust Fund, FLAIR #54-2-270, is administered by the Department of Labor and Employment Security. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-34, Laws of Florida.

The House substituted SB 576 for HB 1367 prior to final passage on March 15, 2000.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 413.445, F.S., provides a revenue source for the fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund serves as a depository for receipt of funds to provide Rehabilitative Services pursuant to Section 413.445, F.S.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are federal grants, deposits, and cooperative agreements. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$123,239,108.42.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
