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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Public Employees Relations Commission Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Public Employees Relations Commission Trust Fund, FLAIR #54-2-558, is administered by the Department of Labor and Employment Security. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-37, Laws of Florida.

The House substituted SB 578 for HB 1369 prior to final passage on March 15, 2000.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 447.205, F.S., creates the trust fund and defines the use of the fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund is used to help defray the cost of providing publications, subscriptions, and copies of records and documents associated with elections.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are fees charged for copying documents. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$41,539.46.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

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III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
