(1) The Unemployment Compensation Trust 24 Fund Benefit Account within the Department of Labor and 25 26 Employment Security, FLAIR number 54-2-765, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State 27 28 Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 29 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 30

are continued.
