Applications filed pursuant to subsection 18 19 (5) or subsection (6) may be required to include the last four 20 digits of the social security numbers of the applicant and the 21 applicant's spouse, if any, and shall include such information 22 if filed for the 2000 tax year or thereafter. For counties where the annual application requirement has been waived, 23 property appraisers may require refiling of an application to 24 25 obtain such information. Section 2.
