Section 3. The President of the Senate and the Speaker 18 19 of the House of Representatives shall direct the staffs of the appropriate committee or committees of their respective houses 20 21 to study during the interim preceding the 2001 Regular Session 22 the issues of whether the Board of Regents should be abolished and the feasibility of transferring responsibilities presently 23 exercised by the board to the boards of trustees of the 24 25 individual universities in the State University System.
