17	Section 3. <u>The prohibition against civil actions</u>		
18	<u>granted firearms manufacturers by this act shall apply only to</u>		
19	<u>a firearms manufacturer that:</u>		
20	<u>(1) Includes with each firearm it sells an external</u>		
21	<u>lock that has to be removed before firing;</u>		
22	<u>(2) Within 2 years of the effective date of this act</u>		
23	<u>equips each of the firearms it sells with an additional lock</u>		
24	<u>built into the firearm;</u>		
25	<u>(3) Adds a second, concealed serial number to each of</u>		
26	<u>the firearms it sells;</u>		
27	<u>(4) Within 1 year of the effective date of this act</u>		
28	<u>develops firearms with child resistant triggers;</u>		
29	<u>(5) Limits new firearms to those that use ammunition</u>		
30	<u>magazines with fewer than 10 rounds; and</u>		
31	<u>(6) Distributes firearms to dealers at gun shows only</u>
