Subsection (8) of section 943.14, Florida 13 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (9), and a new subsection (8) is added to said section to read: 14 943.14 Criminal justice training schools; certificates 15 16 and diplomas; exemptions; injunctive relief; fines.--17 (8) Each criminal justice training school that offers law enforcement, correctional, or correctional probation 18 officer basic recruit training, or selection center that 19 20 provides applicant screening for criminal justice training schools, shall conduct a criminal history background check of 21 22 an applicant prior to entrance into the basic recruit class. A complete set of fingerprints must be taken by an authorized 23 criminal justice agency or by an employee of the criminal 24 justice training school or selection center who is trained to 25 26 take fingerprints. The criminal justice training school or selection center shall submit the fingerprints to the Florida 27 28 Department of Law Enforcement for a statewide criminal history 29 check, and forward the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history check. 30 Applicants found through fingerprint processing to have pled 31

guilty to or been convicted of a crime which would render the 1 applicant unable to meet the minimum qualifications for 2 3 employment as an officer as specified in s. 943.13(4) shall be removed from the pool of qualified candidates by the criminal 4 5 justice training school or selection center. Section 2. Paragraph (g) is added to subsection (1) of 6 7 section 943.17, Florida Statutes, to read: 8 943.17 Basic recruit, advanced, and career development 9 training programs; participation; cost; evaluation.--The commission shall, by rule, design, implement, maintain, 10 11 evaluate, and revise job-related curricula and performance standards for basic recruit, advanced, and career development 12 13 training programs and courses. The rules shall include, but are not limited to, a methodology to assess relevance of the 14 15 subject matter to the job, student performance, and instructor 16 competency. 17 (1) The commission shall: 18 (g) Assure that entrance into the basic recruit training program for law enforcement, correctional, and 19 20 correctional probation officers be limited to those who have 21 passed a basic skills examination and assessment instrument, based on a job task analysis in each discipline and adopted by 22 23 the commission.
