Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Creates provisions in chapter 828, relating to animals, which make it unlawful for: 1. Any person to kill any dog or cat with the sole intent of selling or giving away the pelt of such animal. 2. Any person to possess, import into this state, sell, buy, give away, or accept any pelt of a dog or cat with the sole intent of selling or giving away the pelt of the dog or cat. 3. Any person to possess, import into the state. of the dog or cat. 3. Any person to possess, import into the state, sell, buy, give away, or accept any dog or cat with the sole intent of killing such dog or cat, or having such dog or cat killed, for the purpose of selling or giving away the pelt of the animal. 4. Any person to knowingly engage in the business of a dealer or buyer in the pelts or furs of any dog or cat or to purchase such pelts or furs within the state. 5. Any common carrier to knowingly ship or transport or receive for transportation any dog or cat pelts or furs within this state. 6. Any person to sell or offer for sale at retail or at wholesale in this state any garment or item of clothing or apparel that is made, in whole or in part, of which contains or to which is attached, any dog or cat fur. or fur. 7.
