A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Palm Beach County;
increasing the maximum ad valorem millage rate
which the Children's Services Council of Palm
Beach County is authorized to levy; directing
the Board of County Commissioners to levy the
tax at the rate certified by the council;
requiring a referendum; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
125.901, Florida Statutes, the Children's Services Council of
Palm Beach County is authorized to levy ad valorem taxes in an
amount not to exceed 1.0 mill of assessed valuation of all
properties within Palm Beach County which are subject to ad
valorem county taxes. The Board of County Commissioners of
Palm Beach County shall direct the levy of said additional tax
at the millage rate so certified by the Children's Services
Council of Palm Beach County.

Section 2. The provisions of section 1 which authorize the levy of ad valorem taxation shall take effect only upon the approval by a majority vote of the qualified electors of Palm Beach County, as required by s. 9, Art. VII of the State Constitution, voting in a referendum to be held by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County in conjunction with any subsequent regular primary or general election. The specific regular primary or general election in which the referendum is held shall be determined by the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County. Such election shall be

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held in accordance with the provisions of law relating to
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    elections currently in force in Palm Beach County. If the
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    electors do not approve the levy of ad valorem taxation in the
    referendum held pursuant to this section, no further
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    referendum may be held under this act.
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           Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
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    law.
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
