HOUSE SUMMARY Provides that a debtor's interest in a refund or a credit received or to be received or the traceable deposits in a financial institution of a debtor's interest in a refund or credit pursuant to Section 32 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, is exempt from attachment, garnishment, or legal process.
