A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to laptop computers for  
students; creating a task force to study the  
feasibility of providing a laptop computer for  
every public school student in kindergarten  
through grade 12; establishing membership of  
the task force; providing duties of the task  
force; requiring a report; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. There is established a task force to study  
the feasibility of providing a laptop computer for every  
public school student in kindergarten through grade 12.

(1) The task force shall be composed of the following  
members:

(a) Two members-at-large, appointed by the Governor.

(b) Two members-at-large, appointed by the President  
of the Senate.

(c) Two members-at-large, appointed by the Speaker of  
the House of Representatives.

(d) Three members who represent district school  
boards, appointed by the Governor.

(e) Three members who represent district school  
boards, appointed by the Commissioner of Education.

(f) Two members who are involved in the computer-based  
technology industry, appointed by the Governor.

(g) Two members with knowledge and experience in the  
area of finance or accounting, appointed by the Governor.
