- (3) As used in this section, the term "social anxiety disorder" means a condition that meets the criteria for

Provides that health insurance policies that 18 19 provide mental health benefits must provide coverage for treatment of social anxiety disorder. Provides that policies not providing such coverage are unenforceable. Requires insurers, health maintenance organizations, and nonprofit health care services that provide mental health benefits to include coverage for social anxiety disorder. 20 21 22 Provides that policies or contracts not complying with coverage for social anxiety disorder are unenforceable.
