24 subparagraph 1. are permitted provided that they deal with  
25 material described in paragraph (r) and are included in  
26 permits granted under s. 369.20 or s. 369.25.

27 3.2. All organic material removed ~~removal~~ pursuant to

29 in a manner that will prevent the reintroduction of the
