A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Cabinet reorganization;
providing legislative intent regarding the
impact of the amendment to the State
Constitution on the Treasurer; providing an
effective date.

WHEREAS, in November of 1998 the electorate of Florida
voted to amend the State Constitution, and

WHEREAS, that amendment to the State Constitution
provides for the modification of the membership of the Cabinet
effective January 7, 2003, and

WHEREAS, that amendment provides that the Treasurer
will be removed from the Cabinet but that the Chief Financial
Officer will be assigned the Treasurer's constitutional
duties, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature that
when the Treasurer's constitutional duties are transferred to
the Chief Financial Officer that the transfer of those duties
occurs in an efficient manner so that disbursements from the
State Treasury are not disrupted.

Section 2. This act shall take effect January 7, 2003.

SENATE SUMMARY
