Intent. -- Pursuant to section 191.015, Florida Statutes, this act constitutes the codification of all 30

Service District. It is the intent of the Legislature to 1 2 provide a single, comprehensive special act charter for the 3 Alva Fire Protection and Rescue Service District which includes all current legislative authority granted to the 4 5 district by general law and by its several legislative 6 enactments, as said laws may be amended from time to time, and 7 any additional authority granted by this act. 8 Section 2. Codification.--Chapters 76-413, 81-414, 9 83-449, 83-454, 87-447, 88-545, and 90-388, Laws of Florida, relating to the Alva Fire Protection and Rescue Service 10 District, are hereby codified, reenacted, and amended as 11 12 provided herein. 13 Section 3. The Alva Fire Protection and Rescue Service District, an independent special district, is re-created and 14 the charter for such district is re-created and reenacted to 15 16 read: Section 1. Creation. -- There is hereby made, created 17 and established the Alva Fire Protection and Rescue Service 18 19 District, an independent special district, hereinafter 20 referred to as the district, through the codification and reenactment of the district's several legislative enactments, 21 22 which shall include the following described lands: 23 24 In Township 43 South, Range 27 East, all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 25 26 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 27 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34 and 35 and that 28 portion of Sections 30, 31 and 36 that does not 29 lie in the Lehigh Acres Fire Control and Rescue District, and in Township 43 South, Range 26 30

East all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13,

14, 15, and that portion of Sections 22 and 23
lying North of the Caloosahatchee River and
that portion of Section 24 lying North of the
Caloosahatchee River or lying South of the
Caloosahatchee River and East of Hickeys Creek,
and that portion of Section 25 lying North and
East of Hickeys Creek, and any portion of
Township 44 South, Range 27 East contiguous to
the South Township line of Township 43 South
that does not lie in the Lehigh Acres Fire
Control and Rescue District. All the above is
less all properties within the Lehigh Acres
Fire Control and Rescue District.

Section 2. Governing body.--The district shall be governed by a board which shall consist of five (5) resident electors of the district elected by a vote of the electors of the district pursuant to the laws of Florida, as said laws may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. Officers; powers.--Within sixty (60) days after the election of members of the board, the members shall meet and elect from the membership a chair, a vice-chair, a secretary, and a treasurer; provided, however, the same member may be both secretary and treasurer. The district shall have and the board may exercise those general and special powers prescribed by chapter 191, Florida Statutes, chapter 97-340, Laws of Florida, or any other applicable general law or special law, as said laws may be amended from time to time.

Section 4. Emergency medical and rescue response

services.--The district is authorized to establish and

maintain emergency medical and rescue response services and

acquire and maintain rescue, medical, transport and other 1 2 emergency equipment as prescribed by general law and special 3 law, as said laws may be amended from time to time. 4 Section 5. Policies, rules and regulations and fire 5 code. -- The board is authorized to make and adopt policies, 6 rules, regulations and a fire code for the prevention of 7 fires, for fire control, and for the provision of rescue 8 services within the district. Such policies, rules, 9 regulations and fire code shall be adopted in accordance with applicable general law and special law, as said laws may be 10 11 amended from time to time. 12 Section 6. Taxes; non-ad valorem assessments; impact 13 fees; user charges. -- The district board shall fix and cause to be levied on all property of the district, a millage 14 sufficient to meet the requirements of the adopted budget; 15 16 provided, however, two (2) mills is the maximum that can be 17 levied in any one (1) year, except as provided in chapter 191, Florida Statutes, chapter 97-340, Laws of Florida, or any 18 19 other applicable general law or special law, as said laws may 20 be amended from time to time. In addition, the district shall have such authority to levy non-ad valorem assessments and 21 charge impact fees and user charges as prescribed in chapter 22 191, Florida Statutes, chapter 97-340, Laws of Florida, and 23 any other applicable general law or special law as said laws 24 25 may be amended from time to time. 26 Section 7. Assessment and collection of taxes, 27 assessments, impact fees and user charges. -- Taxes, 28 assessments, impact fees and user charges herein provided for shall be assessed and collected in the manner prescribed by 29 applicable general law or special law, as said laws may be 30 amended from time to time.

1 Section 4. This act shall be construed as a remedial 2 act and shall be liberally construed to promote the purpose for which it is intended which is a codification, reenactment, 3 4 and repeal of the several legislative enactments of the 5 district. 6 Section 5. Except as specifically reenacted herein, 7 chapters 76-413, 81-414, 83-449, 83-454, 87-447, 88-545, and 8 90-388, Laws of Florida, as said laws relate to the district, 9 are hereby repealed. 10 Section 6. In the event any section or provision of this act is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, such 11 12 determination shall not affect the validity of or 13 enforceability of each other section and provision of this 14 act. 15 Section 7. In the event of a conflict of the 16 provisions of this act with the provisions of any other act the provisions of this act shall control to the extent of such 17 conflict. 18 19 Section 8.
