(b) If an applicant proposes mitigation within the 18 19 same drainage basin as the adverse effects to be mitigated and 20 if the mitigation offsets these adverse effects, the governing 21 board and department shall consider the regulated activity to meet the requirements of paragraph (a). However, this 22 paragraph may not be construed to prohibit mitigation outside 23 the drainage basin which offsets the adverse effects within 24 25 the drainage basin. Section 3.
