A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the Secretary of Barbecue;  
creating the position of Secretary of Barbecue  
within the Executive Office of the Governor;  
providing duties of the position; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. SECRETARY OF BARBECUE.--

(1) The position of Secretary of Barbecue is created within the Executive Office of the Governor. The Secretary of Barbecue shall be appointed by the Governor for a 1-year term. The Secretary of Barbecue shall be a ceremonial position. The secretary shall serve without compensation.

(2) The Secretary of Barbecue shall represent the Governor in functions promoting the enjoyment of barbecue and shall promote the diversity of barbecue created by the many cultures represented in the state's diverse citizenry.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
