If there 25 are no daily newspapers in the county where the premises are 26 located, then such notice was published in a weekly newspaper 27 published in the county where the premises are located. If no 28 daily or weekly newspaper is published in said county then 29 notice was posted as provided in s. 50.021. (2) Such notice shall be printed in English in 30

substantially the following form:

Notice is hereby given that application for the sale of (beer, wine, or liquor, as the case may be) on premises will be made by the undersigned at least 5 days after the last date of publication of this notice. Retail sale will take place in a (name of the type of establishment, be it a hotel, club, restaurant, vessel, etc.) located at (street address, city, state, and zip code). Should any person desire to speak to the matter of issuance of a license for said premises, comments should be submitted to the department at (address of the office where the application will be made) in writing, along with the name, address, and phone number of the person making the comments.

(3) The provisions of this section shall apply only to the application for the original license issued and shall not apply to any license renewal by the same applicant at the same location.

 (4) The original copy of the proof of publication shall be submitted to the department with the application for the license.

(5) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this section, in those municipalities or counties where publication of notice is already required by an applicant for a license to sell alcoholic beverages at retail, the local law or ordinance

shall control the publication requirements whether superior or inferior to this section. Where no notice of publication has been enacted at the local level, this section shall control the publication requirements. Section 2.
