I. <u>SUMMARY</u>:

This bill changes the name of the Palm Beach County Health Care District to the Health Care District of Palm Beach County and updates terminology referencing the Palm Beach County Public Health Department.

The bill authorizes the health care district to plan, coordinate, supervise, manage, and take such action as appropriate to implement school health programs as established by the health care district.

The bill also establishes the Glades Rural Area Support Board and provides it with duties, powers, organization, and public access requirements. Furthermore, this bill provides permissive authority and flexibility to the health district with regard to the ownership, operation, and management of an acute-care hospital in the Glades area.

B. PRESENT SITUATION:

The Palm Beach County Health Care District was created in 1987 by chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, through the consolidation of several existing hospital districts and boards. The purpose of creating the health district was to provide a source of funding for indigent and medically needy residents of Palm Beach County and to maximize the health and well being of Palm Beach County residents by providing comprehensive planning, funding, and coordination of health care service delivery. The program elements include, but are not limited to, preventive health services, community nursing services, ambulatory care, outpatient services, hospital services, trauma health services, and rehabilitative services, as feasible.

C. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill changes the name of the Palm Beach County Health Care District to the Health Care District of Palm Beach County and updates terminology referencing the Palm Beach County Public Health Department which was formerly known as a public health unit.

The bill authorizes the health care district to plan, coordinate, supervise, manage, and take such other action as appropriate to implement school health programs as established by the health care district.

The bill also establishes the Glades Rural Area Support Board and provides it with duties, powers, organization, and public access requirements. Furthermore, this bill provides permissive authority and flexibility to the health district with regard to the ownership, operation, and management of an acute-care hospital in the Glades area.

- D. SECTION-BY-SECTION ANALYSIS:
 - Section 1: Amends section 2 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to rename the health care district.
 - **Section 2:** Amends section 3 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to rename the health care district and to authorize the district to plan, coordinate, supervise, manage, and take other action to implement the school health programs established by the district.

- **Section 3:** Amends section 4 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to rename the health care district and update the reference to the county public health department.
- **Section 4:** Adds section 9A. to chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to establish the Glades Rural Area Support Board and provide it with duties, powers, organization, and public access requirements.
- **Section 5:** Amends section 10 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to provide permissive authority and flexibility to the health district with regard to the ownership, operation, and management of an acute-care hospital in the Glades area.
- <u>Section 6:</u> Amends section 11 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to rename the health care district.
- **Section 7:** Amends section 18 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, and renumbers it as section 16 of chapter 87-450, Laws of Florida, to rename the health care district.

Section 8: Provides an effective date of upon becoming law.
