Section 24. Section 403.066, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

403.066 Environmental Justice Impact Statement-- No permit shall be issued for an aquifer storage and recovery project, pursuant to s. 403.065, until the permittee has prepared an environmental justice impact statement and the statement has been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection. The purpose of this statement is to determine whether the proposed project is going to impose environmental or health burdens on low-income, people of color living above the zone of discharge or potentially affected by the project. The environmental justice impact statement shall include, but not be limited, to the following:

1. An identification of low-income, people of color who live above the zone of discharge or who may be affected by

1 the aquifer storage and recovery project;

2 2. An identification of the number and location of
3 private wells located above the zone of discharge or which
4 withdraw groundwater which may be affected by the aquifer
5 storage and recovery project;

6 3. A statement of the aquifer storage and recovery
7 project's impacts on public health and environment and any
8 provision made to minimize the risk to public health and the
9 environment; and,

10 4. An analysis of the social and economic impacts of
11 the aquifer storage and recovery project on the affected
12 community, including changes in property values, community
13 perception, and other costs.
