Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) LEGISLATIVE INTENT.--It is the intent of the Legislature that the residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, be exempt from the requirements related to construction, connection, or maintenance of navigational access channels to or within the waters of the state because of the circumstances of their original construction and sales. It is the further intent of the Legislature that the residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, be exempt from the

permitting requirements and fees set forth in chapters 161, 253, and 403, Florida Statutes, or other sections of Florida Statutes regulating construction, connection, and maintenance of navigational access channels in or through waters of the state from manmade canals within this residential area.

(2) PURPOSE.--

- (a) The residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, shall be exempt from the requirements related to construction, connection, or maintenance of navigational access channels to or within the waters of the state.
- (b) The residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, shall be exempt from the permitting requirements and fees set forth in chapters 161, 253, and 403, Florida Statutes, or other sections of Florida Statutes regulating construction, connection, and maintenance of navigational access channels in or through waters of the state from manmade canals within the residential area of Santa Rosa Shores.
- (c) With respect to each manmade canal within the residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, which is or has been previously connected to waters of the state prior to the effective date of this act, the construction, connection, and maintenance of a navigational access channel 50 feet in width and dredged to a mean low-water depth of 6 feet is permitted for the purpose of providing continuous deep-water navigational passage from manmade canals directly to the 6-foot mean low-water depth contour of continuously navigable water, restoring water quality and viable marine habitat within the canal system, and

preventing further grassbed deterioration within the access
route to deep water.

Section 2. The Department of Environmental Protection shall use the project undertaken pursuant to section 1 as a pilot project for the purpose of determining the best management practices for the propagation of submerged seagrasses in the vicinity of the channel access site in the residential community of Santa Rosa Shores, located in Santa Rosa County, as described in section 1 of this act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
