- 5. The ability to use the technology infrastructure in other local government applications within the service area; and
- 6. Demonstration of willingness and ability of the community to assume ongoing costs to maintain the pilot project for a minimum 5-year period. Such willingness and ability may be demonstrated through intracommunity agreements or other means.
- (c) The Department of Management Services, in consultation with the Department of Education, shall annually evaluate the pilot project based upon consistency with the Sunshine State Standards, as described in section 229.57, Florida Statutes, and with broader community-based standards as appropriate.
