On page 4, between lines 12 and 13, of the bill

insert:

(8) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or restrict a health care practitioner who is not licensed in Florida from providing health care services through telecommunications to a patient temporarily visiting Florida with whom the health care practitioner has an established practitioner-patient relationship so long as the treatment provided is for a non-acute chronic or recurrent illness previously diagnosed and treated by that practitioner and so long as the practitioner holds an active unrestricted license to practice in another state or in another recognized jurisdiction.
