23	provider must proceed, immediately following the effective		
24	date of the suspension or revocation, to conclude the affairs		
25	it is transacting under its license. The provider may not		
26	solicit, negotiate, advertise, or effectuate new contracts.		
27	The department retains jurisdiction over the provider until		
28	all contracts have been fulfilled or canceled or have expired.		
29	<u>A provider whose license is suspended or revoked may continue</u>		
30	<u>to maintain and service viaticated policies subject to the</u>		
31	<u>approval of the department.</u>
