Section 683.23, Florida Statutes, is 27 created to read: 28 683.23 Florida Family Day .-- The Friday preceding 29 Mother's Day of each year is designated "Florida Family Day." On this day, public officials, schools, private organizations, 30 and all citizens are encouraged both to acknowledge and

emphasize the importance of Florida's families to the success and well-being of the state and to reaffirm their commitment to promote strong families within the state. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
