28 Florida Bar.

29 (e) A representative of the Florida Assisted Living
30 Association, appointed by the association.

31 (f) A representative of the Florida Association of

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1 Homes for the Aging, appointed by the association.

2 (g) A representative of the insurance industry who has
3 experience in the insurance markets affecting long-term care,
4 appointed by the Governor in consultation with the President
5 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

6 (h) A member to represent private sponsors of housing
7 for the elderly financed through the United States Department
8 of Housing and Urban Development, appointed by the Secretary
9 of Elderly Affairs.

10 (i) An investment banker who has experience in
11 long-term-care economics, appointed by the Governor in
12 consultation with the President of the Senate and the Speaker
13 of the House of Representatives.

14 (j) An academic gerontologist appointed by the
15 Chancellor of the State University System.

16 (k) A physician whose specialty is geriatrics and who
17 is experienced in treating people with memory-related
18 disorders, appointed by the Florida Medical Association.

19 (l) A member of a Florida chapter of the American
20 Association of Retired Persons, appointed by the association.

21 (m) An individual who has experience with periodic
22 review of nursing homes and other long-term care facilities,
23 appointed by the Attorney General.

24 (n) A representative of the Florida Health Care
25 Association, appointed by the association.

26 (o) A local volunteer long-term care ombudsman with at
27 least 2 years of experience in assisting residents of nursing
28 homes and assisted living facilities, appointed by the State
29 Long-term Care Ombudsman.

30 (p) Two consumer representatives, one appointed by the
31 President of the Senate and one appointed by the Speaker of

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- 1 the House of Representatives.
2 (q) Two members of the Florida Legislature, one
3 appointed by the President of the Senate and one appointed by
4 the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
5 (r) The Minority Leader of the Senate.
6 (s) The Minority Leader of the House of
7 Representatives.
8 (t) A nurse, appointed by the Florida Nurses
9 Association.

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
