Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 316.1935, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.1935 Fleeing or attempting to elude a law enforcement officer; aggravated fleeing and eluding.--

(5)(a) The court may revoke, for a period not to exceed 1 year, the driver's license of any operator of a motor vehicle convicted of a violation of subsection (1).

(b) The court shall revoke, for a period of not less than 1 year and not more than 5 years, the driver's license of any operator of a motor vehicle convicted of a violation of subsection (2) or subsection (3).

(c) The court shall revoke, for a period of not less than 5 years and not more than 25 years, the driver's license of any operator of a motor vehicle convicted of a violation of subsection (4). The period of revocation shall begin upon
