HOUSE SUMMARY Amends the "Veterans' Domiciliary Home of Florida Act" to provide that a veteran must have applied for all financial assistance reasonably available through governmental sources to be eligible for residency in the Veterans' Domiciliary Home of Florida. Amends the "Veterans' Nursing Home of Florida Act" to provide that a veteran must not owe money to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for services rendered during any previous stay at a department facility and must have applied for all financial assistance reasonably available through governmental sources as conditions of eligibility for residency in the Veterans' Nursing Home of Florida.
