Senator Myers moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 53, between lines 18 and 19,

insert:

Section 28. The Department of Health, in conjunction with other affected state agencies, shall develop a hepatitis A awareness and immunization program for food service establishments, day care centers, and any other business settings in which the contraction of hepatitis A threatens the public health and safety. The immunization program shall be offered primarily through the county health departments and shall be a self-supporting program that is funded by user fees. The Department of Health may work with pharmaceutical manufacturers and private associations in developing this program and in securing the hepatitis A vaccine at the lowest possible cost. As part of this program, the department shall distribute materials to potentially affected businesses and individuals.
