1           (2) Based upon the results of this study, establish a  
2 plan for the implementation of a program of long-term  
3 community-based supports and services for individuals who have  
4 sustained traumatic brain or spinal cord injuries who may be  
5 subject to inappropriate residential and institutional  
6 placement as a direct result of such injuries.

7           (a) Records relative to any applicant for or recipient  
8 of program services are subject to s. 381.775, F.S.

9           (b) The program shall be payor of last resort for  
10 program services and expenditures for such services shall be  
11 considered funded services for purposes of s. 381.785, F.S.;  
12 however, notwithstanding s. 381.79(5), F.S., proceeds  
13 resulting from this subsection shall be used solely for this  
14 program.

15           (c) The department shall create, by rule, procedures  
16 to ensure, that in the event the program is unable to directly  
17 or indirectly provide such services to all eligible  
18 individuals due to lack of funds, those individuals most at  
19 risk to suffer the greatest harm from an imminent  
20 inappropriate residential or institutional placement are  
21 served first.

22           (d) Every applicant or recipient of the long-term  
23 community-based supports and services program shall have been  
24 a resident of the state for 1 year immediately preceding  
25 application and be a resident of the state at the time of  
26 application.

27           (e) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to ss.  
28 120.536(1) and 120.54, F.S., to implement the provision of  
29 this subsection.

30           Section 29. Severability.--If any provision of this  
31 act or its application to any person or circumstance is held

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1 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or  
2 applications of this act which can be given effect without the  
3 invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
4 provisions of this act are severable.
