(1) The State Board of Education shall 15 adopt by rule uniform policies and procedures to be 16 17 implemented if a student athlete is arrested for a crime. The uniform procedures shall apply to each institution in the 18 19 State University System, each state community college, and any other institution of higher education that receives state 20 21 funds. The uniform policies and procedures must be included in 22 the institution's handbook, manual, or other similar document regularly provided to faculty and students. 23 (2) As used in this section, the term "student 24 25 athlete" means a student who participates in intercollegiate athletics or who has informed the institution, in writing, of 26 27 the student's intent to participate in intercollegiate 28 athletics. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 30 law. 31
