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A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to actions for medical  
malpractice; amending s. 455.667, F.S.;  
providing circumstances under which a defendant  
health care provider's attorney may interview  
other health care providers ex parte; providing  
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (19) is added to section  
455.667, Florida Statutes, to read:

455.667 Ownership and control of patient records;  
report or copies of records to be furnished.--

(19) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, when  
an action is brought after July 1, 2000, for damages resulting  
from personal injury or death caused by the negligence of a  
health care provider as defined in s. 766.101, the defendant  
health care provider or that health care provider's insurer or  
legal representative may interview, ex parte, any other health  
care provider involved in the patient's care. Such an  
interview may occur only after notice is provided to the  
plaintiff's attorney and must be limited to issues of  
causation; if the action is for personal injury, the patient's  
current physical condition; and the mental impressions of the  
care and treatment rendered by the defendant health care  
provider or any other health care provider alleged to be  
responsible for the patient's injury or death. An interview  
with another health care provider may occur only after the  
plaintiff has given notice of intent to initiate a claim for

1 medical malpractice and before the dismissal, settlement, or  
2 other final resolution of the claim.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

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6 SENATE SUMMARY

7 Authorizes the defendant health care provider in a  
8 medical malpractice action, or the provider's insurer or  
9 legal representative, to interview ex parte any other  
10 health care provider who treated the patient whose  
11 treatment forms the basis for the action. Notice must be  
12 given to the plaintiff's attorney, and the subjects of  
13 the interview are limited.

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
