Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to
address the circumstances under which public and nonprofit
entities may use sales tax exemptions that benefit private
entities either directly or indirectly.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
