18	and insert: <u>(4) The attending physician or physicians shall</u>		
19	<u>provide medical assistance at the facility, to the commission</u>		
20	<u>representative, and medical advice to the referee during the</u>		
21	<u>match, and shall be accorded the cooperation of all commission</u>		
22	<u>representatives and licensees present for the purpose of</u>		
23	<u>performing his or her medical duties. If, in the opinion of</u>		
24	<u>the attending physician, the referee has received an injury</u>		
25	<u>which prohibits the referee from continuing to officiate, the</u>		
26	<u>physician shall notify the commission representative who shall</u>		
27	<u>temporarily halt the match. The injured referee shall be</u>		
28	<u>attended to by the physician until the referee is no longer in</u>		
29	<u>danger or has been transferred to the care of another</u>		
30	<u>qualified person. The commission representative shall then</u>		
31	<u>direct the match to continue under the supervision of the</u>
