Paragraph (e) is added to subsection (2) of 12 section 296.06, Florida Statutes, to read: 296.06 State policy; eligibility requirements.--13 (1) It is the policy of the state to admit residents 14 into the home without regard to race, age, sex, creed, 15 religion, national origin, or any other reason that would 16 17 thereby create a practice of discrimination. However, an applicant's veteran status shall not constitute 18 19 discrimination. 20 (2) To be eligible for residency in the home, a 21 veteran must: 22 (a) Have wartime service or peacetime service as defined in ss. 1.01(14) and 296.02. 23 (b) Have been a resident of the state for 1 year 24 25 immediately preceding application and be a resident of the state at the time of application. 26 27 (c) Not be mentally ill, habitually inebriated, or 28 addicted to drugs. (d) Not owe money to the department for services 29 30 rendered during any previous stay at a department facility. 31 1
