Subsection (44) of section 403.703, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 10 403.703 Definitions.--As used in this act, unless the 11 12 context clearly indicates otherwise, the term: (44) "Source separated" means the recovered materials, 13 14 including metals, paper, glass, plastic, textiles, and rubber, are separated from solid waste where the recovered materials 15 and solid waste are generated. The term does not require that 16 17 various types of recovered materials be separated from each other and recognizes de minimis solid waste, in accordance 18 19 with industry standards and practices, may be included in the 20 recovered materials. Materials are not considered source separated when two or more types of recovered materials are 21 22 deposited in combination with each other in a commercial collection container located where the materials are generated 23 and such materials contain more than 10 percent solid waste by 24 25 volume. 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. 27 2.8 29 SENATE SUMMARY Redefines the term "source separated" to exclude certain recovered materials containing more than 10 percent solid 30 31 waste by volume.
