Section 4. Section 403.065, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

403.065 Aquifer Storage and Recovery Wells.--

(1) There is hereby created a Study Commission on Aquifer Storage and Recovery for the purpose of evaluating this technology and ensuring protection of public health and natural systems from the use of this practice.

(2) The commission shall consist of 11 members as follows:

(a) One member each from the Department of Environmental Protection, Department of Health, and a local health unit;

(b) One member from the United States Environmental Protection Agency;

- 8 (3) The Governor shall make the appointments described
- 9 in subsection (2) after soliciting input from the Speaker of
- 10 the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.
- 11 (4) The Commission shall submit a written report to
- 12 the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
- 13 President of the Senate by February 1, 2001.
