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Senator King moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 7, between lines 29 and 30,

insert:

Section 6.

(1) A health insurance company that offers only dental insurance shall at all times maintain a surplus as to policyholders in the amount required by s. 624.408, Florida Statutes, except that the following amounts shall be substituted for the amount set forth in s. 624.408(1)(a)1., Florida Statutes:

(a) For calendar years 2000 and 2001, \$500,000.

(b) For calendar year 2002, \$1 million.

(c) For calendar year 2003, \$1.5 million.

(2) The provisions of this section apply only to a company that has held a certificate of authority under chapter 636, Florida Statutes, for 4 years prior to the effective date of this act and which applies for a certificate of authority pursuant to chapter 624, Florida Statutes, prior to December

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1 31, 2000.
