27	<u>(3) Each insurer that collects premiums in this state</u>

29	<u>disclose to the policyholder or premium payor the total amount</u>		
30	<u>of premiums paid, the cash value, and the amount of the death</u>		
31	<u>benefits payable under the policy.</u>
