An act relating to insurance adjusters;
amending s. 626.852, F.S.; providing that part
VI of the Florida Insurance Code regulating
adjusters does not apply to employees or agents
of certain governmental entities; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 626.852, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

626.852 Scope of this part.--

(1) This part applies only to insurance adjusters as
defined in this part.

(2) Unless otherwise required by context, the term
"adjusters" as used in this part applies to all licensees
defined as any type of adjuster.

(3) This part does not apply as to life insurance or
annuity contracts.

(4) This part does not apply to third-party
administrators or a person employed by a third-party
administrator holding a certificate of authority pursuant to
ss. 626.88-626.894.

(5) This part does not apply to any employee or agent
of a governmental entity providing services in support of any
self-insurance program adopted by such governmental entity.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
