Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1,
remove from the bill: everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Subsection (8) is added to section 125.01, Florida Statutes to read:

125.01 Powers and duties.--

(8) Counties are prohibited from levying any impact fee for school purposes in an amount in excess of 37.5% of any school impact fee which that county adopted by county ordinance prior to May 1, 1999. If the Legislature funds an amount less than 62.5% of the total impact fee revenue in the Appropriations Act, in any year, a county may increase any existing impact fee to make up the difference.

Section 2. Funds appropriated in the General Appropriation Act for the replacement of school impact fees shall be distributed by the Department of Education to school boards on a pro-rata basis based on the amount of school

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1 impact fees which were enacted by county ordinance prior to
2 May 1, 1999, and collected during the 1999-2000 fiscal year.
3 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
