Section 106. Notwithstanding section 40 of chapter 98-287, Laws of Florida, if a county with a population over 1 million on April 1, 1999, according to the official population estimates from the Bureau of Economic and Business Research, University of Florida, or a municipality within that county, adopts an ordinance providing for a local amendment to the Florida Building Code, and such amendment provides a higher level of protection to the public against hurricane winds, as determined by the Florida Building Commission, the local amendment becomes effective without approval of the Florida Building Commission and is not rescinded pursuant to section 40 of chapter 98-287, Laws of Florida.

Section 107. Notwithstanding section 40 of chapter 98-287, Laws of Florida, if a county or municipality adopts an ordinance providing for a local amendment to the Florida
