16	(45) "Warehouse receipt" means a <u>written</u> receipt <u>or an</u>

19	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2000.
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21	STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
22	<u>SB 224</u>
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24	This committee substitute is different from SB 224 as it does not create an additional method to obtain a lien by a
25	warehouseman against a bailor for goods covered by an electronic notification of receipt, but it does retain the
26	amendment to Article 7 of the Uniform Commercial Code which includes an electronic notice of receipt within the definition
27	of "warehouse receipt."
