No suspension or revocation of a driver license shall take effect 26 27 until 30 days from the date that the registered letter is 28 delivered, or notice is received indicating that the problem 29 requiring a revocation or suspension has been resolved. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 30 31 law.
