A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to driver licenses; creating s.  
322.2617, F.S.; providing for a notice by  
registered letter to a person whose driver  
license is going to be suspended or revoked  
prior to the suspension or revocation;  
prohibiting suspension or revocation for a  
certain time period; providing an effective  
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 322.2617, Florida Statutes, is  
created to read:

322.2617 Driver license notification required prior to  
suspension.--In addition to any other requirement provided for  
in this chapter or in any provision of the Florida Statutes  
with respect to the suspension or revocation of a driver  
license, prior to the suspension or revocation of a driver  
license, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles  
must first send a registered letter to the address on the  
person's current driver license, providing that person with a  
30-day notice of the reason or reasons for the suspension or  
revocation together with instructions on what the person may  
do to avoid the suspension or revocation, if possible. No  
suspension or revocation of a driver license shall take effect  
until 30 days from the date that the registered letter is  
delivered, or notice is received indicating that the problem  
requiring a revocation or suspension has been resolved.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.
