14-166A-00 See HB 1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act making a supplemental appropriation; 3 providing an appropriation to help fund the 4 building of the National World War II Memorial; 5 providing an effective date. 6 7 WHEREAS, the national campaign to establish a World War II Memorial on the National Mall in Washington, D.C., is 8 9 seeking contributions from the various states in an amount 10 equal to one dollar for each state resident who served in uniform during World War II, and 11 12 WHEREAS, most states have already introduced legislation to participate in this "dollar per veteran" 13 campaign, and an ever-increasing number of states have 14 15 subsequently passed that legislation to provide for their portion of the funds sought under the campaign, and 16 17 WHEREAS, it is estimated that the number of veterans who were residents of Florida when they served in World War II 18 19 is 248,000, and 20 WHEREAS, it is estimated that nearly 600,000 veterans 21 of World War II proudly call Florida home, and 22 WHEREAS, it is fitting, proper, and an honor for the 23 State of Florida to contribute its portion to the national campaign for such memorial, NOW, THEREFORE, 24 25 26 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 27 28 Section 1. The sum of \$248,000 is appropriated from 29 the General Revenue Fund to the American Battle Monuments 30 Commission for deposit into the National World War II Memorial Fund for the purpose of helping to fund the building of the 31 1
